Rebecca Aadland is a soulful singer-songwriter from Minneapolis, Minnesota. Her songs span styles of folk, rock, indie and blues. Having also worked as a music teacher, psychotherapist, and public speaker, she is drawn to stories of overcoming tragedy and loving boldly. The unexpected death of her husband from a massive heart attack in 2022, took Rebecca to a dark and lonely place, unable to write or perform her music. Determined to make sense of the pain, she wrote the line, "I could use a miracle, my world went black years ago". Her new single was born. Recorded and produced by **Kevin Bowe** (Johnny Lang, Paul Westerburg, 3 Dog Night) and mastered by **Greg Reierson** (Prince, The Cure, Dan Wilson), the track features drummer **Greg Schutte** (Ryan Bingham, Mickey Hart, Cyndi Lauper), bassist **Nick Salisbury** (Brian Fallon, Ryan Bingham) and **Kevin Bowe** (above) on lead guitar and keyboards. **Rebecca** provides vocals and rhythm guitar. She is now actively writing and recording her third album with Kevin Bowe. Since her highly acclaimed album **Stronger Broken** (2022), this upbeat new rock song breathes fresh air and hope. She is also enjoying a newfound love relationship. New to her all-star cast of musicians is keyboardist **Tommy Barbarella** (Prince, Miley Cyrus, Nick Jonas), who will be joining her band at The Icehouse, 9/28/25.
